### Cotes du Rhone

'Les Vignes du Prince', Côtes du Rhône 2017

Created in 1924, the Cellier des Princes is the only cooperative cellar in the Châteauneuf du Pape area. Spicy and juicy plummy fruit woven with appealing warmth from the Southern Rhône.

Grenache 80%, Mourvèdre 10%, Syrah 10%

### Minnervois Cuvée Classique

Domaine La Rouviolle, Cuvée Classique 2016

Flavours of the 'garrigue' of the South of France, redolent of spicy red fruits, smooth and beautifully balanced. Syrah 40%, Cinsault 35%, Carignan 20%

Château Mèrigot, Côtes de Bourg 2016
